2003 Award Winners – Announced October 10

- The Air Canada People's Choice Award for Most Popular Film (popular vote)
Winner: KAMCHATKA (Argentina/Spain) directed by Marcelo Pineyro.
- The Federal Express Award for Most Popular Canadian Film (popular vote)
Winner: THE CORPORATION (British Columbia), directed by MARK ACHBAR and JENNIFER ABBOTT. Runner-up is THE DELICATE ART OF PARKING (British Columbia), directed by TRENT CARLSON.
- The Citytv Western Canada Feature Film Award (juried prize, for Best Feature Film from Western Canada); award and \$12,000 from Citytv.
Winner: NATHANIEL GEARY for ON THE CORNER (British Columbia).
- The Keystone Award (for Best Young Western Canadian Director of a Short Film); new award with \$5,000 cash prize sponsored by International Keystone Entertainment. Juried prize.
Winner: JESSE MCKEOWN for THE BIG CHARADE (British Columbia).
- The National Film Board Award for Best Documentary Feature. Juried prize.
Winner: LOS ANGELES PLAYS ITSELF (USA), directed by Thom Andersen
